- (a) the number and name of registered government/private vessels in the country along with the revenue earned during the last three years;
- (b) the details of laws/rules/regulations for registering of vessels;
- (c) whether any difficulty has been reported in the registration of the vessels; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof along with the measures taken to simplify the procedure?

Answer

(a) A total of 31 government and 171 private vessels have been registered in the last three years (upto 31.1.2015) as per details attached as Annexure-I.

The total revenue collected for registration of aforesaid vessels in the last three years (upto 31.1.2015) is Rs.15, 35, 085. The year-wise breakup of which is as follows:

Financial Year Revenue earned

2012-2013 Rs. 7,18,461 2013-2014 Rs. 5,39,728 2014-2015 Rs. 2,76,896 (upto Jan 15)

- (b) Indian ships are registered under Section 22 of the Merchant Shipping Act, 1958 (as amended) and the Merchant Shipping (Registration of Indian Ships) Rules 1960.
