**Will the Minister of LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT be pleased to state:**

- (a) the details of major model hospital and medical colleges established/being established under the Employees' State Insurance Corporation (ESIC) in the country, State/UT-wise;
- (b) the present policy/norms adopted by the Government/ESIC for admission of students to these medical colleges;
- (c) whether the Government/ESIC is considering a new policy with regard to admission in ESIC medical colleges; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

**Answer**

MINISTER OF STATE FOR STEEL, MINES, LABOUR & EMPLOYMENT (SHRI VISHNU DEO SAI)

(a): State/UT-wise details of Employees' State Insurance Corporation (ESIC) major model hospitals established/to be established under are given at Annex-I & II. The State/UT-wise details of ESIC medical colleges approved/being established under ESIC is as per Annex-III.

(b): The admission policy for admission of students to ESIC Medical Colleges is as under:

All India Quota: 15% of total available seats in each of its Medical Colleges.

State Government Quota: As per the policy of respective State applicable to un-aided non minority Institutions; or, in the absence thereof, as may be mutually agreed to, between the respective State Government and the ESI Corporation. It varies from State to State.

ESIC Management Quota: The remaining seats after allocation to All India Quota and the State Govt. Quota. These are pooled for allotment on All India basis, to 'Wards of Insured Persons'.
