- (d) the steps being taken by the Government to win over villagers on various issues such as land, differential pricing of bamboo in different States and demonetisation?

- (a) to (c). Change of tactics, in areas of operation and tactics is a constant and on-going effort of insurgent groups such as Left Wing Extremists. No significant change in the pattern of frequency or geography of violence or activity has however been reported from States such as Madhya Pradesh, Maharashtra and Chhattisgarh in the recent past.
- (d). The Government remains in constant touch with the people through public representatives, the democratic system and the administrative machinery to keep them informed with regard to decisions of the Government.
