- (d) if so, the details thereof and if not, the time by which it is likely to be introduced;
- (e) whether any panel has been formed to study the proposed system; and
- (f) if so, the details thereof?

(a) to (£): The Government in consultation with the Election Commission has vide Notification No. S.O. 2470(E) dated 14 August, 2013 notified the Conduct of Elections (Amendment) Rules, 2013 making necessary amendments in the Conduct of Electionl Rules, 1961 enabling the Election Commission to use Voter Verifiable Paper Audit Trail (WPAT) in elections to the House of the People and State Legislative Assemblies. Thereafter, the Election Commission used it in a bye-election in Nagaland, in select constituencies of Assembly elections in Mizoram held on 25 November, 2013, in one constituency of Delhi Assembly elections held on 4 December, 2013 and in certain constituencies of the recently held general elections to Lok Sabha-2014.
