iii) The Employees` Compensation Act, 1923 iv) The Maternity Benefit Act, 1961

v) The Payment of Gratuity Act, 1972

(d): The Government: has also enaicted the Unorganised Workers' Social Security Act, 2008 to provide IFor social security and welfare of all unorganised workeirs.
