- (d) whether the Union Government has received any proposals from the Government of Madhya Pradesh regarding urban sports infrastructure scheme or any other sports competition; and

1. Laying of synthetic athletic track at Devi Ahilya Vishwavidyalaya, Takshshila Campus, Khandwa Road, Indore. 5.50 (08.12.2014)
2. Construction of Multi-purpose Indoor Hall at T. T. Nagar Stadium, Bhopal. 6.00 (28.07.2017)</pre>

The financial assistance is provided to sportspersons under National Sports Development Fund (NSDF). However, State-wise information of sportspersons supported under this Scheme is not maintained.

The following project proposals were received from Govt. of Madhya Pradesh under the erstwhile Urban Sports Infrastructure Scheme (USIS):

A project of laying of Synthetic Hockey Surface at Ranital Sports Complex, Jabalpur, Madhya Pradesh was sanctioned on 18.10.2011 at an estimated cost of Rs.4.81 crore out of which Rs.3.62 crore was released as first instalment, the Utilization Certificate (UC) for which became due

on 31.03.2013 which was awaited despite repeated reminders even at the level of Chief Minister, Madhya Pradesh. As a consequence of this, the project proposals mentioned at S. No. 1 to 4 above were not considered.

The following project proposals have been received from Govt. of Madhya Pradesh under Khelo India Scheme:-
