**Will the Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE be pleased to state:**

(a) The details of the Government/ private hospitals registered under the Transplantation of Human Organs Act (THOA), 1994 for liver transplantation in the country;

(b) The number of liver transplantation surgeries conducted in these hospitals during each of the last three years and the current year along with its success rate, hospital-wise; and

(c) Whether the Government proposes to provide liver transplantation facility in the Central Government hospitals, if so, the details thereof and the time by which it is likely to be available?

(a) Health being a State subject, this information is not maintained centrally. However, as per the available information, the following Government/private hospitals in Union Territories are registered for liver transplantation under Transplantation of Human Organs Act(THOA), 1994:

Government

1. G.B.Pant Hospital, New Delhi.
2. Institute of Liver & Billiary Sciences, Vasant Kunj, New Delhi.
3. PGIMER, Chandigarh.
4. Army Hospital, (R & R), Delhi Cantt.
5. AIIMS, New Delhi.

Private

1. I.P. Apollo Hospital, Delhi
2. Sir Ganga Ram Hospital, N Delhi.
3. Dr. B.L.Kapur Hospital, N Delhi.

(b) The number of liver transplantation surgeries conducted in the above mentioned hospitals of Union Territories is enclosed at Annexure The success rate of liver transplantation or any other organ transplantation is not maintained centrally.

(c) The following central Government Hospitals are already providing Liver Transplantation Facilities:

1. PGIMER, Chandigarh.
2. Army Hospital, (R & R), Delhi Cantt.
3. AIIMS, New Delhi.
