(a) The number of persons died due to snakebites in the country during each of the last three years and the current year, State/UT-wise;

(b) Whether anti-snake venoms/vaccines are available in sufficient quantity at health centres/district hospitals across the country;

(c) If so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor; and

(d) The steps taken/being taken by the Government for providing adequate anti-snake venoms/ vaccines to the State health departments?

(a): Information relating to state/UTrwise number of deaths due to snakebite, as reported during the years 2011, 2012, 2013 and 2014, is given in the Annexure.

(b) to (d): Health is a State subject. Therefore, it is primarily the responsibility of the State Governments to ensure availability of antisnake venom serum in the health care facilities. However, under the National Health Mission (NHM), funds are provided to states for procurement of drugs including anti-snake venom serum.

In addition to manufacturing units of anti-snake venom serum in private sector, Central Research Institute, (CRI) Kasauli and Hafikine Bio-Pharmaceutical Corporation Limited (A Government of Maharashtra Undertaking) manufacture anti-snake venom serum. Requests for additional quantity of anti-snake venom serum are received from State Governments from time to time. The State Governments are: to procure anti-snake venom serum from the manufacturers directly as per their requirements. State Governments have also been requested to convey their requirements of anti-snake venom serum in advance to the Ministry to enable better assessment of demand by Government undertakings.
