- (a): Yes, Madam.
- (b): Initiatives taken by the Government to boost manufacturing in solar industry are:
- (i) provision of domestic content requirement in various schemes to source cells and modules of domestic origin
- (ii) Exemption of Customs and Excise duty on input raw material required for manufacturing of cells and modules
- (iii) Capital subsidy for manufacturers under Special Incentive Package Scheme (SIPS) & Modified Special Incentive Package Scheme (M-SIPS) by DEITY.
- (iv) developers are free to set up manufacturing units also under the Solar Park scheme launched by the MNRE.

- (d): Government has not signed any MoUs in this regard.
