(a) The aim and objective of National Rural Drinking Water Programme (NRDWP) is to provide every rural person with adequate sale water for drinking, cooking and other basic domestic needs on a sustainable basis, with prescribed water quality standards, which should be conveniently accessible at all limes and in all situations.

At the beginning of every financial year State-wise allocation is made on the basis of following criteria:

i) Rural population 40
ii) Rural SC and ST population 10
iii) States under DDP, DPAP, HADP 40
and special category Hill
states in terms of rural areas
iv) Rural population managing rural 10
drinking water supply schemes
weighted by a Mangagement

#### Under NRDWP the funding pattern between center and state is as below:

(b) The assistance provided by the Union Government to the States under the Programme during the last three years and current year. State/UT-wise is given at Annexure-1

(c) The tolal number of rural habitation and population covered with piped drinking water supply during the above period, Slate/UT-wise is at Annexure-II

(d) Under the `Kumbha`, a Lift Drinking Water Supply Project, State Government of Rajasthan had taken administrative and financial approval of Rs. 954.70 crore for 5 towns and 258 villages in district Jhunjhunu. The work has been started in 2013 and scheduled to be completed in 2016. Under the NRDWP, an assistance of Rs. 224.36 crore is planned. The source of water supply project is Indira Gandhi Canal.
