**Will the Minister of LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT be pleased to state:**

- (a) the total number of Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs) set up in the country especially in the backward and tribal areas including Maharashtra presently, State/UT-wise;
- (b) whether the Government has any proposal to set up more ITIs in such tribal and backward areas including in Gadchiroli-Chimur Parliamentary constituency of Maharashtra; and
- (c) if so, the details thereof, State/UT-wise and if not, the reasons therefor?

**Answer**

MINISTER OF STATE (IC) FOR LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT (SHRI BANDARU DATTATREYA)

- (a): Presently, there are 11,964 Industrial Training Institutes (Govt. 2284 & Pvt. 9680) in the Country & in the State of Maharashtra 829 number of ITIs (Govt. 390 + Pvt. 439) are affiliated to National Council for Vocational Training. State-wise details are placed at Annex -I.
- (b): Directorate General of Employment & Training under Ministry of Labour & Employment has formulated a scheme titled "Skill Development in 34 Districts Affected by Left Wing Extremism". Under the Scheme, two districts namely Gondiya & Gadchiroli are covered in the State of Maharashtra. In these two districts, two ITIs & four Skill Development Centers (SDCs) are proposed to be set up.
- (c): Details of the funds released to the nine States are placed at Annex-II.
