- (c) In August, 2010, Ministry of Culture constituted a Committee on Zonal Cultural Centres (ZCCs) under the Chairmanship of Shri Mani Shankar Aiyar, Member of Parliament (Rajya Sabha). The Committee was required to look into the functioning and performance of the seven ZCCs set up in the Country and make suitable recommendations. The Committee in its Report submitted on 11th April, 2011 made 92 recommendations pertaining to the strengthening and functioning of ZCCs. Most of the recommendations have been accepted by the Government.
