Will the Minister of ENVIRONMENT, FORESTS AND CLIMATE CHANGE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the habitations located around wildlife sanctuaries in India have been declared or proposed to be declared as buffer zones;
- (b) if so, the details thereof along with the relocating and rehabilitation plans of these habitations; and
- (c) the details of compensation provided/likely to be provided to the displaced persons/families?

(a)and (b) The habitations around the Wildlife Sanctuaries in general have not been declared as buffer zones, nor is there any such proposal under consideration of the Government. However in respect to Tiger Reserves, the Wild Life (Protection) Act, 1972 provides for core areas and buffer areas. The village relocation is not envisaged from the buffer areas of tiger reserves.
