(a) whether the Government has taken a decision to absorb surrendered militants drawn from Manipur and Assam in two auxiliary battalions of the BSF and SSB forces with a strength of 750 each;

(b) if so, the details thereof;

(c) whether a similar drive in the north-east in the early 1970s was successful prompting the Government to revive the plan;

(d) if so, whether the Government is also considering to undertake such rehabilitation measures in other parts of the country as well; and

(e) if so, the details thereof?

Answer

(a) & (b): No final decision has been taken on creation of two Auxiliary Battalions of the Border Security Force (BSF) and Sashastra Seema Bal (SSB).

(c): In the year 1973, two Auxiliary Battalions were raised in BSF. Subsequently, these two battalions were converted to regular battalions.

(d) & (e): No proposal is under consideration to undertake such measures in other parts of the Country.
