- (c) the total funds likely to be allocated in this regard; and

(a) to (d): Ministry of Information and Broadcasting proposes to setup a National Centre of Excellence in Animation, Gaming and Visual Effects under the 12th Plan scheme at a cost of Rs 57 Crore. Planning Commission has given in-principle approval to the project. The objective of the scheme is to impart quality education and to ensure increased skilled manpower. The scheme would also ensure increasing ownership of Intellectual Property by Indians in animation/gaming/visual effect sector leading to increased revenues, employment generation, cultural pay-off and a subtle leveraging of India's soft power in the global arena. Stakeholders have been requested to submit revised proposal, based on which Detailed Project Report would be prepared for further action.
