Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Delhi-Saharanpur Highway via Baghpat-Baraut has been neglected for many years, if so, the details thereof;
- (b) whether Government proposes to declare Delhi-Yamnotri State Highway into National Highway;
- (c) if so, the details thereof; and
- (d) the steps taken by the Government in this regard?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS (SHRI PON. RADHAKRISHNAN)

(a) to (d) This Ministry is primarily responsible for the development & maintenance of National Highways in the country. Delhi-Saharanpur Highway via Baghpat-Baraut is not a National Highway. Moreover, there is no proposal of this Ministry to declare this State Highway as National Highway. The road portion in Uttarakhand from Herbertpur- Vikasnagar-Barkot is National Highway No. 123 and road from Barkot- Hanumanchatti-Phulchatti (near Yamnotri) is National Highway No. 94. These National Highways are presently being maintained by Uttarakhand PWD in traffic worthy condition.
