**Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:**

- (a) the length of each National Highway (NH) in Maharashtra including four and six lane highways;
- (b) the number and names of highways connected with Golden Quadrilateral;
- (c) whether work on any of the aforesaid NH is in progress; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof along with the delay in work on any of the aforesaid NH and the reaction of the Government?

**Answer**

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN MINISTRY OF ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS (SHRI PON RADHAKRISHNAN)

- (a) The length of each National Highway (NH) in Maharashtra is enclosed at annexure A
- (b) The National Highway No-8 (Delhi-Mumbai) & NH-No-4 (Mumbai-Chennai) is connected with Golden Quadrilateral.
- (c) & (d) Yes, Madam. The work of 6-laning of Pune - Satara on NH-4 is in progress. This work is delayed due to inadequate planning & deployment of resources by the Concessionaire and delay in Forest Diversion & Land acquisition.
