WIDENING OF ROADS IN CHHATTISGARH

**Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:**

- (a) the details regarding present status of widening work on each National Highways in various States along with Chhattisgarh;
- (b) the National Highways proposed by the Government to be widened/four laned in the State of Chhattisgarh by the Government;
- (c) whether Bilaspur-Raipur and Champa-Korba roads are proposed to be widened in Chhattisgarh;
- (d) if so, the details thereof; and
- (e) the action taken in this regard so far?

**Answer**

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS (SHRI PON. RADHAKRISHNAN)

- (a) At present 1241 are ongoing works of development including widening of National Highways in the various States across the country.
- (b) Raipur Bilaspur section of NH-200, Raipur-Dhamtari section of NH-43 and Bilaspur-Urdawal section of NH-200 are proposed to be widened/four laned in the State of Chhattisgarh.
- (c) to (e) Bilaspur-Raipur in Chhattisgarh is being 4/6 laned by National Highways Authority of India which is at bidding stage and development of Champa-Korba roads in Chhattisgarh is in initial stages & project is under preparation.
