- (a) Rs.1360.60 crore has been sanctioned for four-laning of NH-34 between Km 16 to Km 93 in West Bengal during the last three years;
- (b) The work from Km 16 to Km 23.20 has just started. The work from Km 115 to Km 193 has achieved 48.41% progress and Fourlaning in 37.76 Km has been completed.
