**Will the Minister of URBAN DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:**

- (a) whether the Government has drawn up any master plan for beautification of Delhi;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the Government proposes to involve all stakeholders to work out modalities of the beautification plans; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof and the present status of the plan?

**Answer**

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF URBAN DEVELOPMENT [SHRI BABUL SUPRIYO]

- (a) & (b) Master Plan for beautification of Delhi is a State subject. It is dealt by Local Bodies and Delhi Development Authority (DDA). DDA has informed that in the Master Plan of Delhi, there is a provision for developing parks for recreational use. They undertake new plantation in parks and road sides, develop new lawns, clean vacant plots/lands, maintain green areas/central verge, and repair and paint tree guards, garden benches, provide toilets and dustbins etc. Similarly, local bodies also carry out similar works in their areas.
- (c) & (d) DDA has undertaken the proposal for involving the private sector/agencies and RWAs for maintenance and up-gradation of parks and development of the areas along the water body. This development will contribute towards beautification of the city.
