## Will the Minister of PERSONNEL, PUBLIC GRIEVANCES AND PENSIONS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has proposed to relax reservation rules for jobs to ex-servicemen;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether this will affect the unemployed youth in the country; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof and the steps taken in this regard?

## **Answer**

Minister of State in the Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievances and Pensions and Minister of State in the Prime Minister's Office (DR. JITENDRA SINGH)

- (a) & (b): In August 2014, the Department of Personnel & Training has issued instructions to the effect that if an ex-servicemen applies for various vacancies before joining any civil employment, he/she can avail of the benefit of reservation as ex-serviceman for any subsequent employment. This benefit would be available only in respect of vacancies which are filled on direct recruitment and wherever reservation is applicable to the ex-servicemen.
