Will the Minister of COMMUNICATIONS AND INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY be pleased to state:

(a) whether all the Post Offices have been provided with the facilities of E-mail, Internet and Computers in the country;

(b) if so, the details thereof, State-wise including Madhya Pradesh;

(c) if not, the reasons therefor and the steps taken by the Government in this regard;

(d) whether the Government has any proposal for re-opening of certain closed Post Offices; and

(e) if so, the details thereof and the steps taken by the Government in this regard?

Answer

(a) All the 25,145 departmental post offices have been provided with computer facilities. E-mail and Internet facilities have been provided in 24,465 departmental post offices.

(b) State-wise details of Post Offices provided with the facilities of E-mail, Internet and Computers including Madhya Pradesh is annexed (Annexure-'A').

(c) E-mail and Internet facilities shall be provided in the remaining 680 departmental post offices by 31st March 2015.

(d) & (e) The Government has no such proposal. However, the Post Offices which are temporarily closed as a result of temporary merger, non-availability of accommodation etc. are reopened as and when suitable accommodation becomes available and when prescribed norms for opening of Post Offices are fulfilled.
