- (a) The Sports Authority of India (SAI) implements the following Sports Promotional Schemes at Sub-Junior, Junior and Senior level.
- 1. a) National Sports Talent Contest (NSTC)
- b) Indigenous Games and Martial Arts (IGMA)
- c) Akhara
- 2. Army Boys Sports Company (ABSC)
- 3. SAI Training Centre (STC)
- 4. Special Area Games (SAG)
- a) Ext. Centres of STC/SAG for wider Coverage
- 5. Centre Of Excellence (COE)

SAI has eleven Institutional/Regional Centres which are responsible for implementing and monitoring SAI Sports Promotional Schemes.

(b) SAIs Sports Promotional activities and the funds for conducting these activities is allocated Region-wise, and not State-wise. During the current Financial Year, the budget approved for the various regions of SAI are as follows:-
