- (a) whether the Government has implemented India Statistical Strengthening Project (ISSP) at the State and Sub-State Level;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the details of funds allocated for the purpose, State/UT-wise along with the status of implementation of ISSP?

- (a) & (b): The India Statistical Strengthening Project (ISSP), which aims at strengthening the State Statistical Systems, is at present being implemented in 14 States and 1 Union Territory, namely, Karnataka, Gujarat, Rajasthan, Andhra Pradesh, Telangana, Tamil Nadu, Bihar, Sikkim, Mizoram, West Bengal, Odisha, Kerala, Jharkhand, Manipur and Lakshadweep. In all, 34 States/UTs (except Goa and Chandigarh) have agreed to participate in the Project.
- (c): An amount of Rs. 648.97 crore has been allocated under the project. The implementation of the project is in various stages. The details of funds allocated to the States/UT up to October, 2014, are given in the statement annexed.
