There are 99 cotton / man-made fibre textile mills in Panipat district. Also as per the Handloom census 2009-10, there are 7,967 handloom weavers and allied workers in the State of Haryana, Of which 7,902 weavers and allied workers are from Panipat District alone.

(b) & (c): In order to facilitate the growth of textile industry in the country, including in Panipat in Haryana, Government has launched various policy initiatives and schemes. Some of the schemes / measures are Technology Upgradation Fund Scheme (TUFS), Scheme for Integrated Textile Parks (SITP), Scheme for Development of Technical Textiles, Integrated Skill Development Scheme, Schemes for the development of the Powerloom Sector, National Handloom Development Programme, Handloom Weavers Comprehensive Welfare Scheme, Yarn Supply Scheme and Comprehensive Handloom Cluster Development Scheme.
