ESTABLISHMENT OF THERMAL POWER PLANTS

**Will the Minister of POWER be pleased to state:**

- (a) the details of thermal power plants along with their production capacity, State-wise;
- (b) whether the Government proposes to establish many such power plants in the country during the impending years;
- (c) if so, the details thereof, State-wise/ location-wise;
- (d) whether many existing thermal power plants are facing acute shortage of coal;
- (e) if so, whether the Government is contemplating to import coal and provide subsidy on the imported coal to fulfill the shortage; and
- (f) if so, the details thereof?

**Answer**

THE MINISTER OF STATE (INDEPENDENT CHARGE) FOR POWER, COAL AND NEW & RENEWABLE ENERGY ( SHRI PIYUSH GOYAL )

- (a) : The State-wise details of thermal power plants along with their generation capacity is at Annex-I.
- (b) & (c) : The State-wise details of the thermal power plants proposed to be established in the country during 12th Five Year Plan is at Annex-II.
- (d) to (f) : As on 20.11.2014, 29 Nos. Thermal Power Plants are having coal stock less than 4 days. To meet the shortage of coal, the annual target of import of coal during the year 2014-15 is set at 94 Million Tonne. Providing subsidy on import of coal to fulfill the shortage of coal is not being contemplated at present.
