(c) whether the Government is considering to take manufacturing growth on a sustainable basis to 10 per cent over the long term; and

(a) & (b): No Madam, there is no specific invitation to identified persons from these countries. However, Government intends to give impetus to manufacturing in the country including investment from across the border.

(c) & (d): The National Manufacturing Policy recognizes the need of manufacturing sector growing at the rate of 12% to 14 %. Government has launched 'Make in India' initiative to give a boost to manufacturing activities. Under 'Make in India' programme the components include improving the ease of doing business, creation of new infrastructure through industrial corridors, smart cities, skill development, nurturing innovation and allowing FDI in new sectors like defence, construction and railway infrastructure.
