- (b) if so, the areas in which the possibility of growing spices and data have been identified so far; and
- (c) the incentive/assistance/subsidy being worked out by the Government to cultivate spices in these regions?

- (a) & (b): There is no proposal of the Central Government to survey Rajasthan and Haryana States for production of Spices.
- (c): Government of India provides subsidy under Mission for Integrated Development of Horticulture at the rate of Rs. 12000/- per hectare.
