(c) The Department is implementing three schemes namely, `Development of Inland Fisheries and Aquaculture`, `Development of Marine Fisheries, Infrastructure and Post Harvest Operations` and "National Fisheries Development Board (NFDB)" for enhancement of fish production in the Country.

(d)to(h) Hon'ble Finance Minister in his budget speech 2014-15 has made announcement of blue revolution with a provision of Rs. 50.00 crore which aims to enhance fish production in the County. Draft of the scheme has been formulated which is subject to necessary approvals.
