STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PARTS (a) TO (c) OF LOK SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO. 180 FOR ANSWER ON 18.7.2014

The Government does not directly export arms, ammunitions and weaponry systems to any country. As per DGFT Policy Circular No.45 (RE-08)/2004-2009 dated 4th December 2008, Department of Defence Production (DDP) issues 'No Objection Certificate' (NOC) for export of goods, which are in the nature of military stores.

- 2. DRDO had sought the advice of DDP on the export of DRDO designed and developed products, which have been manufactured by various companies in India. The requisite advice has been intimated to DRDO regarding the procedure for issuing NOC by DDP to concerned companies for such exports.
- 3. The Government has not carried out any comparative study of weapon exporting countries.
