(a) to (c) Yes, Madam. In the last three years, 278 training programmes have been organised which benefited 30,895 participants. The State-wise details can be seen at Annexure-I.

A sum of Rs. 546.20 lakhs was allocated and an expenditure of Rs. 429.09 lakhs has been incurred on these training programmes. The State-wise details can be seen at Annexure-II.
