- (b) if so, whether the Railways propose to run a passenger train on the said route;
- (c) if so, the details thereof and the time by which this service is likely to be introduced; and
- (d) if not, the reasons therefor?

Answer

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI MANOJ SINHA)

(a): A private siding line has been laid by M/s South Eastern Coalfield Limited for transportation of their coal from mines from Gevra to Dipika.

(b) to (d): Being a private siding, no passenger trains can be run on this line.
