- i) To develop Character, Camaraderie, Discipline, Leadership, Secular outlook, Selfless service and Sprit of adventure among the youth.
- ii) To create a Human resource of organized trained and motivated youth, to provide leadership in all walks of life and be always available for the service of the nation.
- iii) To provide a suitable environment to motivate the youth to take up a career in Armed Forces.

Activities - The training is carried out under four boad heads:-

- i) Institutional training and camps etc.
- ii) Social Service and Community Development.
- iii) Adventure and Sports
- iv) Youth Exchange Programme with other countries.
