- iii) To provide a suitable environment to motivate the youth to take up a career in Armed Forces.

Activities - The training is carried out under four boad heads:-

- i) Institutional training and camps etc.
- ii) Social Service and Community Development.iii) Adventure and Sports
- iv) Youth Exchange Programme with other countries.
