Will the Minister of FINANCE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government is considering imposing higher tax on beedis or smokeless tobacco to curb their consumption;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) if not the reasons therefor; and
- (d) the measures taken or proposed to be taken to adopt a comprehensive taxation policy for all tobacco products and discourage the tendency of switching over to relatively cheaper tobacco products?

Answer

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE (SHRI JAYANT SINHA)

- (a): As of now there is no proposal under consideration to impose higher tax on beedis or smokeless tobacco to curb their consumption.
- (b) & (c): Do not arise in view of (a) above.
- (d): In the Budget 2014-15, Excise Duty on cigarettes was increased by 72% for cigarettes of length not exceeding 65 mm and by 11% to 21% for cigarettes of other lengths. Similar increases were made on cigars, cheroots and cigarillos. Basic excise duty on pan masala was increased from 12% to 16%, on unmanufactured tobacco from 50% to 55% and on jarda scented tobacco, gutkha and chewing tobacco from 60% to 70%.
