- (a) whether a Government delegation has recently visited South Korea to attract investment by foreign electronics manufacturers in the country;

- (c) whether the Government has cleared investment proposals of some top foreign companies in electronics manufacturing;
- (d) if so, the details thereof; and
- (e) the details of the CSR initiatives taken by such foreign companies during the last three years in India?
