Will the Minister of FINANCE be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of the public and private sector bank branches closed during the last three years in rural and urban areas, bank and State-wise along with the reasons therefor; and
- (b) the steps taken by the Government to prevent closure of bank branches in rural areas?

Answer

THE FINANCE MINISTER (SHRI ARUN JAITLEY)

- (a) As per information received from Reserve Bank of India (RBI), details of branches closed by Public and Private Sector banks during the last three years State-wise and Bank-wise are at Annexure. Closures are broadly of the nature of permanent closure, conversion into non-administratively independent offices or merger with a branch of the same bank.
- (b) In terms of RBI guidelines on Branch Authorization, closure of even loss making branches a trural centres having a single commercial branch (excluding Regional Rural Bank branch) is not permitted, as closure would render the centre unbanked. In other cases, of rural branch at a centre served by more than one commercial bank branch, closure of a rural branch needs approval of RBI.
