(b) if so, the details thereof indicating the corporate houses which have set up their retail outlets in smaller cities, as on date;

(c) whether it is a fact that these corporate houses are opening retail outlets in smaller towns in violation of the conditions permitting their entry into retailsss market at national level; and

(d) if so, the details thereof and the reaction of Government thereto?
