Will the Minister of NEW AND RENEWABLE ENERGY be pleased to state:

- (a) the total installed solar power capacity in Punjab;
- (b) whether the Government has been able to fulfil the Solar Renewable Purchase Obligation for the year 2012-13 in Punjab; and
- (c) if so, the details thereof along with the measures taken to increase the capacity of solar power generated in the State?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF STATE FOR POWER, COAL & NEW AND RENEWABLE ENERGY (INDEPENDENT CHARGE) (SHRI PIYUSH GOYAL)

- (a): The total installed solar power capacity in Punjab is 57 MW.
- (b): No, Madam. Solar RPO for FY 2012-13 was (0.07%) 30.48 Million Unit, which could not be achieved till March 2013 and was allowed to be carried forward by Punjab State Electricity Regulatory Commission. This was then achieved by December 2013.
- (c): The required Solar Renewable Purchase Obligation was 30.48 Million Unit. During Financial year 2012-13, 12.49 Million Unit was achieved. Remaining, 17.99 Million Units was achieved by December 2013. More capacity is being planned to increase capacity of solar power generated in State.
