- (a) whether the Government has estimation of the unutilised bio-waste and sludge in the country;
- (b) if so, the details thereof including the volume that is created, the volume collected and volume treated, State/UT-wise;
- (c) whether the Government proposes to set up bio-fuel plants make use of the unutilised bio-waste; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof including amount of energy that could be generated by this waste?

Answer

- (a)&(b): The estimated State-wise quantity of surplus biomass is given in the Annexure. Estimation of quantity of sludge has not been carried out.
- (c)&(d): Ministry of New and Renewable Energy has extended support for eleven research and development projects on production of biofuels from ligno-cellulosic biomass feedstock. The expected production of biofuels is about 250-300 litres per tonne of ligno-cellulosic biomass. The State-wise potential for generation of power from the surplus biomass estimated to be available in the country is given in the Annexure.
