Will the Minister of OVERSEAS INDIAN AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has assessed the number of immigrant Indians who have already returned to the country from the middle-east, Africa, etc., and if so, the details thereof, State-wise;
- (b) whether the Government has received any request from the Government of Kerala requesting Central Assistance for Annual Interest Subsidy for imple- menting Comprehensive Rehabilitation Package-Self Employment investment opportunity in the State; and
- (c) if so, the details thereof and the action taken by the Government to provide requisite assistance to such State Governments in this regards?

Answer

- (a) Recently, 6977 persons have been evacuated from Iraq and 3284 persons have been evacuated from Libya. However, there may be other persons who have come back to India on their own & the assessment in this regard is not feasible.
- (b) Yes, Madam.
- (c) Rehabilitation of returnees rests mainly with the State Governments. The Ministry of Overseas Indian Affairs (MOIA) has advised the State Governments that the existing State/ Central Sector Schemes be used for rehabilitation. Presently, the Ministry does not have any scheme for providing assistance to State Governments for rehabilitation of returnees from abroad.
