(c) Swachh Bharat Mission (Gramin) has been launched on 2nd October, 2014, which aims at attaining a 100% Open Defecation Free India by 2019, by providing access to toilet facilities to all households. Government of India has also targeted to provide toilets, separately for boys and girls, in all schools by 15.8.2015 under programmes of the Department of School Education and Literacy.
