Will the Minister of ATOMIC ENERGY be pleased to state:

- (a) whether India has signed nuclear deal with Canada, Kazakhstan, Argentina, Namibia and Mongolia for supply of uranium;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and the details of uranium received from these countries so far;
- (c) whether the Government is facing any hurdles to sign nuclear deal with Japan; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF STATE FOR PERSONNEL, PUBLIC GRIEVANCES & PENSIONS AND PRIME MINISTER'S OFFICE (DR.JITENDRA SINGH):

- (a) India has signed a nuclear deal only with Kazakhstan for supply of uranium, from out of the above mentioned countries.
- (b) As per the above agreement, M/s. NAC Kazatomprom, Kazakhstan has supplied 2100MT of Uranium Ore concentrate.
- (c) & (d) Talks to finalise a Civil Nuclear Agreement with Japan are ongoing.
