- (a) the details of the housing projects sanctioned by the Government in different parts of the country under the Rajiv Awas Yojana (RAY) to replace slums, State-wise, including Maharashtra, Haryana and Odisha;
- (b) the total amount likely to be spent in these projects, State-wise;
- (c) the number of slum dweller families likely to be benefited under this Yojana by 2015;
- (d) the details of provisions made for various types of basic civic facilities to be provided under Rajiv Awas Yojana;
- (e) the details of location identified in the various cities across the country for construction of house under RAY, State wise; and
- (f) the progress of work under RAY in the various cities across the country, State wise?

Answer

- (a) to (c): The State-wise details of the housing projects sanctioned, amount spent and houses constructed under the Rajiv Awas Yojana (RAY), State-wise, including Maharashtra, Haryana and Odisha is at Annexure-I. A total number of 1,60,931 slum dweller families are covered under approved projects as on date.
- (d): Central Assistance under RAY is admissible to States/UTs for providing housing and basic civic amenities like water supply, sewerage, drainage, solid waste management, approach and internal road, street lighting etc.
- (e) and (f):City-wise, State-wise details of the projects along with progress is at Annexure-II.
