Will the Minister of URBAN DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has schemes to support the infrastructure development of tier-2 and tier-3 cities and if so, the details thereof:
- (b) the details of plan outlay in the current plan for the above schemes and the funds spent in this regard during the last three years and the current year, State-wise; and
- (c) the cities in Maharashtra granted funds from the above said scheme and the amount approved for such projects per city?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF URBAN DEVELOPMENT (SHRI BABUL SUPRIYO)

(a) to (c): In order to support the efforts of the State Governments, the following schemes have been implemented by the Government to provide infrastructure facilities for the areas falling under the municipal limit of the towns and cities eligible under these schemes.

Jawaharlal Nehru National Urban Renewal Mission (JnNURM)-The Government launched Jawaharlal Nehru National Urban Renewal Mission (JnNURM) on 03.12.2005 with a view to provide financial assistance to the State Governments for creating urban infrastructure

facilities for all the cities in the Country with a reform oriented agenda. JnNURM had two components namely, Urban Infrastructure and Governance (UIG) catering for 65 mission cities and Urban Infrastructure Development Scheme for Small and Medium Towns (UIDSSMT) which includes all other towns/cities in the country excluding mission cities. Details of Additional Central Assistance (ACA) committed and released for utilization under UIG sub-mission and under UIDSSMT of JnNURM State-wise including Maharashtra during the last three years are at Annexure-I and Annexure-II. No funds have been released in the current year as the Mission has ended on 31-03-2014

Scheme for Urban Infrastructure Development in Satellite Towns around Seven Million Plus Cities – Under the scheme funds are provided for improvement of urban infrastructure facilities among other activities in Satellite towns of seven Mega cities. Details of fund released, State-wise including Maharashtra, Year-wise during the last three years and current year under the UIDSST are at Annexure-III. North Eastern Region Urban Development Programme (NERUDP) – Under the scheme which is assisted by Asian Development Bank (ADB), financial assistance is provided for improvement of urban infrastructure in 5 capital cities of North Eastern States viz Agartala (Tripura), Aizawl (Mizoram), Gangtok (Sikkim), Kohima (Nagaland), and Shillong (Meghalaya). Details of fund released, State-wise, Year-wise during the last three years and current year under the NERUDP are at Annexure-IV. 10% Lump Sum Scheme for Benefit of North Eastern Region including Sikkim – Under the Scheme projects are sanctioned for improvement of urban infrastructures and basic services.

Details of fund released, State-wise, Year-wise during the last three years and current year under the 10% Lumpsum provision Scheme for North East Region are at Annexure-V.
