**Will the Minister of URBAN DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:**

- (a) the total number of flats built for Commonwealth Games (CWG) 2010 and the funds spent for the same, type-wise;
- (b) whether condition of the above flats has deteriorated and if so, the details thereof and the reasons therefor;
- (c) the details of funds spent on their upkeep during the last three years and the current year, type-wise;
- (d) whether any proposal is under consideration for early auctioning of the CWG flats; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof along with the revenue likely to be earned by the Government as a result thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

**Answer**

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF URBAN DEVELOPMENT ( SHRI BABUL SUPRIYO )

- (a) : Delhi Development Authority (DDA) has informed that total of 1168 flats were constructed in the Commonwealth Games Village under public private partnership (PPP) mode as per details given below:
  - (i) 2 bedroom flats – 32 numbers
  - (ii) 3 bedroom flats – 764 numbers
  - (iii) 4 bedroom flats – 209 numbers
  - (iv) 5 bedroom flats – 163 numbersThe whole expenditure on construction of these flats was borne by the private partner. DDA has not spent any money on construction of these flats.
- (b): No, Madam.
- (c): DDA has informed that no money has been spent by DDA on the upkeep of these flats till date.
- (d)&(e): No such proposal has been received from DDA
