Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has cleared expressways in the country including Agra-Lucknow;
- (b) if so, the details thereof, State/UT-wise;
- (c) the funds allocated/released/spent for each expressway in the country during the last three years; and
- (d) the details of the pending cases received from each State/UT and time by which cases are likely to be cleared?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS (SHRI PON. RADHAKRISHNAN)

(a) & (b) The Government has envisaged construction of 1000 km of expressways under NHDP Phase VI to be selected out of the followings:

7.	Delhi-Agra	200	UT of Delhi & State of UP

Agra-Lucknow expressway is a State Highway being developed by Govt. of Uttar Pradesh.

(c) The projects are under feasibility stages. The Expenditure incurred in last 3 years, i.e. 2011-12, 2012-13 & 2013-14 is Rs. 4.54 Crore, Rs. 12.54 Crore & Rs. 71.84 Crore respectively.

(d) Apart from the above there are no cases of any pending expressway.
