(a) Out of 88 District Headquarters (DHQs) towns of North-Eastern Region, 23 DHQs towns are already connected with 2 lane road and for 35 DHQs, projects have already been sanctioned under Special Accelerated Road Development Programme in North East (SARDP-NE). For the remaining 30 DHQs, 2 lane connectivity projects are yet to be sanctioned.

(b) Funds allocation under SARDP-NE, during last three years and the current year are as follows:-

(c) SARDP-NE is targeted for completion by March, 2017.
