## MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE (SMT. NIRMALA SITHARAMAN)

- (a): Yes, Sir. A request has been received in this regard from the Government of Gujarat. The request was examined and it has been decided to reduce the basic customs duty on vessels and other floating structures for breaking up from 5% to 2.5% w.e.f. 11th July, 2014.
- (b) and (c): The reduction in customs duty will help promote recycling of steel and boost production of secondary steel.
- (d): Does not arise in view of (b) above.
