Will the Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE be pleased to state:

- (a) the amount spent per student for imparting medical education and training in the All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS), New Delhi:
- (b) whether a number of AllMS students leave India to work abroad;
- (c) if so, the details thereof and the reasons therefor indicating the number of such cases reported during each of the last three years and the current year;
- (d) the steps taken/proposed to be taken by the Government to retain such doctors and to prevent them from migrating to other countries after completion of study; and
- (e) whether AllMS has started a cadaver training and research facility for young surgeons and if so, the details thereof along with the steps being taken by the Government to set up such training facilities in all the major Government hospitals across the country?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SHRI JAGAT PRAKASH NADDA)

(a): No separate head of account is maintained by the All India Institute of Medical Sciences(AllMS), New Delhi for medical education. All the activities of the Institute likepatient care, academic and research are interlinked and complement to one another. However, details of expenditure (Plan and Non-Plan) incurred by the Institute during the last three years and number of students in the Institute on the last day of previous three financial years are as under:-

- (b) to (d): No such data is maintained/available in the Institute. After implementation of the recommendation of 6th Pay Commission, Pay and perks of faculty members have been revised.
- (e): AllMS, New Delhi is imparting cadaver training and is also having research facility for young surgeons. The young surgeons are taught by the experienced faculty members about operative techniques of complex surgical procedure. A cadaver lab has also been setup in Jai Prakash Narayan Apex Trauma Center, AllMS, New Delhi. National Institute of Mental Health and Neuro Sciences, Banglore is providing cadaver training to trained (university certified) neurosurgeons from all over the India over a 3-day short term training programme.
